



EVCD: EV Cable Defender

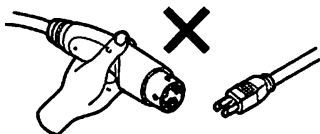
Protect your cables. Save your doors. Let's get set up.



ONE GUIDE FOR EVERY EVCD MODEL Solo = 1 ch | Duo = 2 ch | Trio = 3 ch

Max line OD: Arc 22 mm (0.87 in) | Ridge 23 mm (0.91 in)

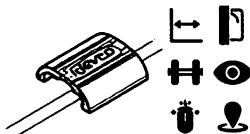
1 CHECK YOUR FIT



Make sure the flexible line fits comfortably.

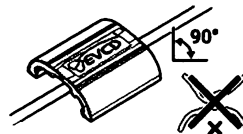
Tip: Never force a line, plug or connector!

2 PLACE IT RIGHT



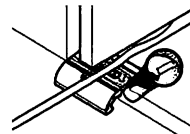
Set on a clean, flat threshold. Keep clear of all moving hardware and photo-eyes.

3 ROUTE STRAIGHT



Run the line completely straight and perpendicular - 90 degrees - to the garage door.

4 WATCH FIRST CLOSE



Stand clear and close slowly. Confirm the seal rests evenly on the guard, not the cable.

! STOP IMMEDIATELY IF: The door twists, bounces back, shifts the guard or leaves a gap. Never force it closed.

SAFETY + CARE

- **KEEP CLEAR:** People and pets. Follow opener instructions.
- **INSPECT:** Check guard, cable and threshold before each use.
- **DO NOT BYPASS:** Sensors, auto-reverse or opener force settings.
- **ONLY USE:** Lines rated for the equipment, load and location.

CARE + RECHECK

- ✓ **CENTER:** Keep the line straight and untwisted.
- ✓ **TEST:** Door safety reversal as directed.
- ✓ **STORE:** Remove and store the guard after use.
- ✓ **STOP:** Discontinue use if damaged or shifting.
- ✓ **CLEAN:** Mild soap and water only.
